
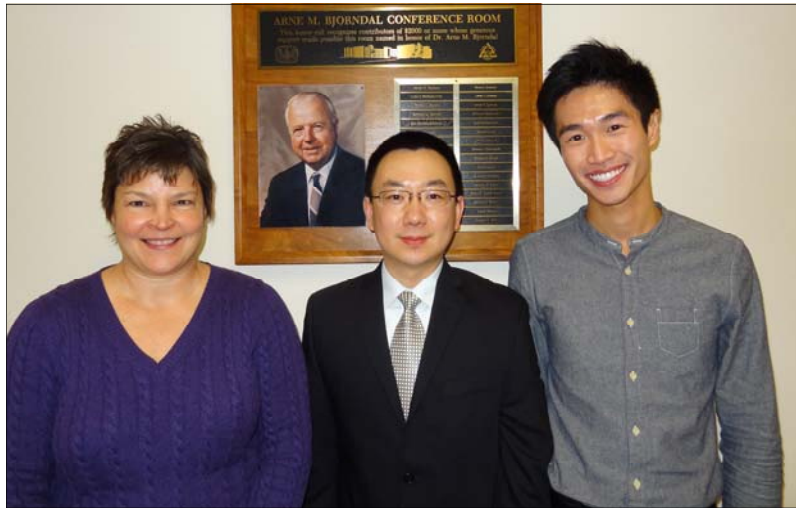

The College of Dentistry began participating in the CRCFHC in October 2011.

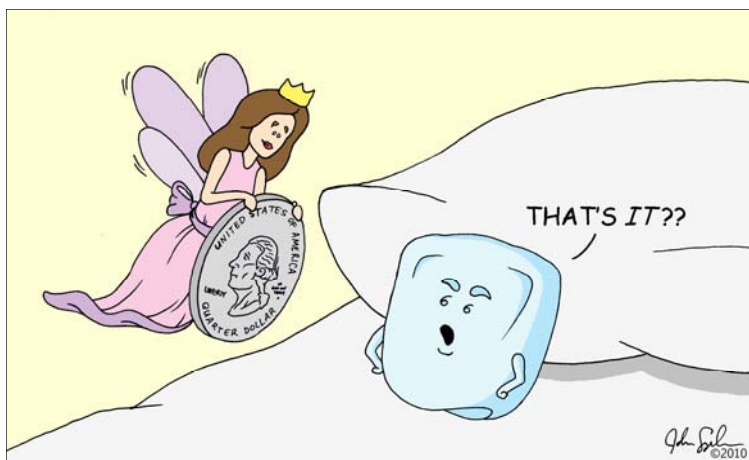
