Program completion rate: Program is typically completed within 36 months. Program duration may be extended depending upon requirements to complete Master of Oral Science degree program. For the last ten years we have had a 100% on-time completion rate for the Certificate in Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology.

Placement rate for students completing the certificate program: For 13 students completing the Certificate in Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology in the last 10 years, eight have obtained academic appointments, and four have entered private practice as a dentist/dental specialist and one has joined in the Air Force as an Oral Maxillofacial.
