Program Completion Rate: Program is typically completed within 24 months. Over the last ten years we have had a 97% on-time completion rate for the Certificate in Pediatric Dentistry.

Placement Rate for Students Completing the Certificate Program: Over the last ten years, we have a 100% placement rate for those who have completed the certificate program. Of these 37 graduates, 32 went on to private practice, 3 went on to a career in academics, 1 went on to a career in public health, and 1 chose further educational pursuit.
