ADVANCE REGISTRATION: Pre-registration is recommended at least 14 days before course date. This will enable us to send course/game times and parking permits. If football ticket allocation is exhausted, you will be enrolled and notified of non-availability unless you indicate on the registration form that you do not want to enroll without tickets.

CANCELLATION/REFUNDS: Fees paid will be refunded less a \$40 per person processing fee following notice of cancellation. For registrations charged to your credit card, the refund will be credited to your account. Refunds will not be granted for cancellations received after the course begins. If insufficient enrollment necessitates canceling a course, all fees will be refunded.

CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT/RECORD KEEPING: CEU verification will be provided (by email following the program) only for those individuals completing/submitting a CEU card at the completion of the program. Each registrant must provide a unique email address to ensure his or her receipt of CEU certificate electronically. Credit will be appropriately adjusted for those individuals who do not attend the entire program.

FOOTBALL TICKETS: Tickets are available on a limited basis and are priced as follows: 9/16 North Texas \$45; 9/23 Penn State \$95; 10/7 Illinois \$60; 10/28 Minnesota \$80; 11/4 Ohio State \$95; and 11/18 Purdue \$60. All tickets will have a \$1 per ticket handling fee (limit two tickets per registrant per game). Tickets will be sold on an individual basis and not as “season tickets.” To order tickets, you must register and prepay for the continuing education program (by mail application or by calling the credit card line). Tickets MUST be picked up at the course registration desk before course adjournment. Tickets will not be mailed. Payment for tickets cannot be refunded except when ticket supply is exhausted during the pre-registration period. Tickets cannot be transferred with a registration to another course.

PARKING: Complimentary parking is available in the parking lot adjacent to the Dental Science Building. A parking pass will be sent to you several days prior to course date. Registrations received within 14 days of course date cannot be guaranteed a parking pass. **Guaranteed parking will ONLY be available until 7:45 a.m.** If you are staying for the game, DO NOT remove your vehicle from the lot.

HOUSING: Housing arrangements are the responsibility of each individual. You may call the continuing dental education office for recommendations if you desire lodging. We **do have** blocks of rooms available for each weekend – you can find them in the Friday CE course brochures.
