AT THE COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM, PARTICIPANTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO:

Baker and Stein:

- Discuss the extent of the opioid abuse problems in the United States;
- Recognize the role of the dentist in contributing to the current public health emergency;
- Explain the relative pain relief effectiveness of non-opioid and opioid agents in acute pain; and
- Discuss the benefits and risks of specific pain control regimens for effective dental analgesia.

Parker:

- Recognize the signs and symptoms of OSA and sleep bruxism;
- Have foundational information to formulate treatment plans for OSA and sleep bruxism; and
- Appreciate the connection or not between OSA, sleep bruxism and TMD.

Elgendy:

- Discuss the principles, materials and clinical techniques to achieve excellent esthetic and function smile design.

Guzman-Armstrong:

- Identify the need for better evaluation of the removal of carious tissue;
- Understand the technique that preserves dentin in the restorative process and ultimately improves long-term clinical outcomes; and
- Provide the evidence and rationale behind the new guidelines for caries removal at different stages.

Mahrous:

- Understand the indications, requirements, and steps of fabricating implant supported fixed detachable restorations.
